ORDER

On December 11, 2009, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the State of Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter referred to as "Board"), a consent order signed by Mr. Dudley L. Greenway (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") was accepted and a Final Order was issued by the Board. In said consent order Respondent agreed to pay a fine of \$300.00 (three hundred dollars) and obtain two (2) professional development hours within sixty (60) days of Final Order. Respondent also agreed that failure to obtain two (2) professional development hours within sixty days of Final Order date shall cause his license to practice land surveying in the State of Alabama to be revoked.

Correspondence mailed to Respondent via regular and certified mail from Mr. William R. Huett, Assistant Executive Director of the Board on March 4, 2010 informed Respondent he was non-compliant with the agreed upon consent order. Respondent was also informed his non-compliance would be discussed by the Board at its regularly scheduled meeting of March 25-26, 2010 and he had the opportunity to appear and present information to the Board when the matter was discussed.


At its March 25-26, 2010 regularly scheduled meeting, the Board reviewed information relative to Respondent's non-compliance with the agreed upon consent order and the consequences of non-compliance contained in said consent order. After this review and discussion, the Board determined Respondent's license to practice land surveying in the State of Alabama is **Revoked**.


