ORDER

On March 31, 2016, the Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors accepted an agreed upon Consent Order regarding Case No. 2015-51-B. Please recall that in that Consent Order you agreed to provide upon request a list of the surveying jobs you performed within a one-month period and that survey(s) would be randomly selected for review for compliance with the standards of practice. In the consent order Respondent also agreed that failure to comply with any term of the consent order would cause his professional land surveyor license to be **revoked**, pending ratification by the Board.

In a letter dated September 19, 2016, Respondent was requested to provide copies of the following surveys, and all supporting data to include: contracts, notes, record plats used, surrounding deeds and maps, and other data used to prepare the surveys.

- 8-22-16 Boundary only – 127 Kirkley Drive 35023
- 8-23-16 Lot Certificate – 3733 James Hill Circle 35023
- 8-23-16 Subdivision - Watsons Resurvey 35023

Respondent was further instructed to provide this information to the Board office prior to **October 7, 2016**. As of January 30, 2017, the Board office has not received the requested documents.

A letter dated December 16, 2016, was sent to Respondent via regular and certified mail

that informed him that his non-compliance with the agreed upon consent order of March 31, 2016, would be discussed by the Board at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 31 – February 1, 2017. The letter further advised him that he could appear at the meeting and present information to the Board when the matter was discussed. The signed certified mail receipt card was received in the Board office on December 22, 2016.

At its January 31 – February 1, 2017, regularly scheduled meeting, the Board reviewed the information relative to Respondent's non-compliance with the agreed upon consent order and the consequences of non-compliance contained in the consent order. After this review and discussion, the Board determined Respondent's license to practice land surveying in the State of Alabama is **Revoked**.


