

**MINUTES OF THIRD MEETING
2014-2015 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
April 30, 2015**

Chair Foust called the third meeting of the 2014-2015 Board to order at 8:00 A.M., Thursday, April 30, 2015 at the at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed.

15-66. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to adopt the proposed agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the second meeting of the 2014-2015 Board were received for approval.

15-67. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy that the minutes of the second meeting of the 2014-2015 Board held February 5, 2015 be approved as written. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Action items from previous board meetings were reviewed.

OPEN FORUM

The Board went in the open forum portion of the agenda to allow individuals that had requested time to make a presentation to the Board the capability to do so. Mr. Jeff Lucas, P.L.S. and Mr. Joe Meads, P.E.

had identified that they would like to discuss the requirements for quality based selection (QBS). Mr. Lucas also identified that he wished to address the Board about possible changes to the definition of "Practice of Surveying".

Mr. Jeff Lucas, as ASPLS President, made a presentation to the Board in which he was asking the Board to consider changing the requirement for the licensees to use QBS. Mr. Lucas identified that he was only addressing QBS as it applied to land surveying and would not discuss how it should apply to the engineering profession. It was Mr. Lucas's contention that QBS was unenforceable for the smaller projects and requested that the Board consider that an exemption threshold of \$15,000 be added to the QBS section of the Code of Ethics.

Mr. Joe Meads, P.E., as a member of ASCE and ACEC, and representing his own firm, made a presentation to the Board in which he identified the differences between the Board's requirements for QBS and what the language is for the architects. He identified that it is not mandated that architects use the QBS process and in fact routinely disregard QBS when soliciting work. He posed the question if it was a violation of the architect's code of ethics if the architect asked for a bid from a profession that was ruled by QBS. He asked the Board if they would consider asking the Board of Architects to change their law to mandate the use of QBS.

There was an open discussion on both presentations regarding QBS. Board members voiced their opinions as well as other individuals present. There was opposition to the suggested changes presented by ASPLS. It was noted that the board staff has been helpful in educating clients about the QBS process. The key takeaways from the open discussion was that education and enforcement of the QBS process were critical.

Mr. Lucas, representing himself, made a presentation to the Board in which he was requesting the Board to consider making changes to the definition of surveying to identify the differences between an original survey and a retracement survey and what the standards of practice should be for those types of surveys.

There was an open discussion on the future of the land surveying profession. Mr. Foust as the Board Chair, established a task force to look at the current issues in the surveying profession and the future of the profession. Mr. Christy was appointed as the chair of the task force with Mr. Johnson and Mr. Grace as members. Societies that are involved in surveying will be invited to be members of the task force.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The board's sub-committee that had been tasked to look at possible law changes provided their draft of proposed law changes. The primary changes were identified. Mr. Johnson identified that he would like to see an alternate path for land surveying licensure. Mr. Christy identified that this would be included as one of the charges for the newly formed land surveying task force. The Board agreed that the draft needed to be circulated to the stakeholders for their inputs.

- 15-68. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Willis that in order to gain feedback and support for the changes that the Board should develop a PowerPoint presentation outlining the proposed changes, to have a series of town hall meetings with 1 – 2 board members at each meeting to discuss the proposed changes, to widely

distribute the proposed changes and to provide similar information at the various society meetings. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed proposed changes to Chapter 16 of the Administrative Code. The dialogue concerned the composition of the Investigative Committee and the process that should be used by the Investigative Committee.

15-69. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Investigative Committee should be composed of a board member, the board attorney, and the executive director. MOTION CARRIED 5-2 with Mr. Johnson and Mr. Willis voting in the negative.

A further motion was made and a friendly amendment by Mr. Christy was added. The final motion reads:

15-70. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Ms. Hyde that all decisions of the Investigative Committee must be unanimous and in the event they are not unanimous a sanitized version of the case will be presented to the Board for their input back to the Investigative Committee. MOTION CARRIED 6-1 with Mr. Johnson voting in the negative.

The Executive Director will draft the necessary changes to the Administrative Code.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2014- 2015 statistics.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action. Cases that are being recommended for closure or where they are recommendations from the investigative committee are discussed in a sanitized format so that in the event the Board suggests another course of action that the due process of the investigation has not been compromised. Respondent's information is not divulged until after a proposed consent order is accepted and a final order is approved.

15-71. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Barter to accept the recommendations and findings of the Administrative Law Judge in regards to Mr. Roddy Fitzgerald and Commodore Steel Buildings. Both were found guilty of offering and providing engineering without having a licensed PE in responsible charge. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Willis recused. Case 2013-39-C.

15-72. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Barter to close Case 2014-06-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Foust recused.

15-73. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 2014-07-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Foust recused.

- 15-74. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 2014-19-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-75. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept the proposed consent order and issue the Final Order for Case 2014-17-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Steve Braxton Green, PLS #11843 had performed a property survey which contained violations of the accepted standards of practice . The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Green will pay a \$1,500 fine; his license will be suspended for 6 months with the suspension being stayed for 2 years; for two years, at six month intervals, he must submit a list of the property boundary surveys he has performed; the Board may randomly select survey(s) to be reviewed for compliance with standards of practice and if found to be in violation the six month suspension will become effective immediately; and the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-76. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed consent order and issue the Final Order for Case 2014-22-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Laurence Harvey Zander, PLS #25647 had produced a survey which contained violations of the accepted standards of practice. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Zander will pay a \$1,500 fine; his license will be suspended for two years with the suspension being stayed; at the Board's request he must submit within one month of the request a list of the property boundary surveys he has performed; the Board may randomly select survey(s) to be reviewed for compliance with standards of practice; and the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Willis recused.
- 15-77. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace to close Case 2014-24-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Willis recused.
- 15-78. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy to close Case 2014-29-C with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 15-79. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Grace to close Case 2014-31-C with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Ms. Hyde recused.
- 15-80. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Barter to close Case 2014-32-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 15-81. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Willis that there was probable cause that Mr. William A Gordy, Sr., PE #21427 had designed an engineered onsite waste water management system which contained errors. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that he will pay a \$500 fine, he is formally reprimanded and the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Grace recused. (Case 2015-02-B)

- 15-82. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 2015-05-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Johnson and Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-83. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept the proposed consent order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-08-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Engineering Group of the Southeast LLC, CA-3118-E had failed to identify a branch office that was offering AL services. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that the firm will pay a \$500 fine, the firm is cautioned to insure all future changes made to the CA comply with the Law and Rules of the Board, and the consent order and final order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Willis recused.
- 15-84. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Willis to close Case 2015-13-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 15-85. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Ms. Hyde to close Case 2015-14-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 15-86. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy to close Case 2015-20-B with no action, but to send a letter to the professional engineer explaining what qualifies as supervision of individuals for engineering licensure. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Grace recused.

The Board discussed if there was currently a method to monitor the cases where the respondent is tasked to routinely provide documents for review. It was explained that the current process is to use the services of sitting board members and the volunteer tech advisors. The possibility of having paid technical advisors, to be paid at a lower hourly rate than the normal labor rate, was discussed. The advisors would be on call and used on an as needed basis. Ms. Hyde as the law enforcement advisor agreed to work with the staff to develop a proposed process for monitoring cases.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. Frazier Christy, Advisor

The Board reviewed a request from Great Basin College to have their BA in Land Surveying and Geomatics approved as a land surveying curriculum. The Board reviewed the program's curriculum and the individual course descriptions. Questions were raised on how the lab and field work was accomplished in this distance learning based program.

- 15-87. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Christy to delay on acting on Great Basin's request until further information can be provided by Great Basin on how the labs and field work are accomplished. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

The Board approved the results of the February and April state specific portion of the land surveying examination.

- 15-88. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Willis to accept Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination; to approve the results of the ALLS Exams given February 11, 2015 and April 17, 2015; to license those individuals who passed the ALLS Exams having previously passed the FLS and PLS Exams and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board discussed the status of the PS and ALLS examinations. NCEES was requesting an update on how the Board planed on offering the ALLS examination once the PS examination converts to CBT format. It was the Board's decision that the last time that the state specific exam will be offered at the NCEES arranged test location will be April 2016 (the last time the paper pencil version of the PS exam is offered). The Surveying Task Force established earlier in the board meeting will be tasked to provide recommendations on what format the ALLS exam should be offered.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of the certificate of authorizations issued since the February 2015 Board Meeting were reviewed.

- 15-89. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-2021-E, CA-2647-E, CA-4064-E, and CA-4959-E through CA-5010-E and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-787-LS, CA-957-LS and CA-1068-LS through CA-1077-LS issued since the February 5, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board considered the certificate of authorization applications that had exceptions.

- 15-90. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Barter to approve the CA application for Allen Brinkley Construction, Inc. MOTION CARRIED 6-1 with Mr. Christy voting in the negative.
- 15-91. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Barter to approve the CA renewal application for Meadows Engineering and Consulting Services Inc with the understanding that the reinstatement fee for a late renewal is due. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board considered a request from a firm who was requesting that they be allowed to have the term "Engineer" in their title without having a Certificate of Authorization issued. STS Engineering Services Inc. identified that they exclusively provided contract engineering and Designated Engineering Representative (DER) support to the aviation industry which is under the FAA regulation and as such is exempted from the Board's Licensure Law.

- 15-92. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Johnson to approve STS Engineering Services Inc.'s request to use the firm's name without first obtaining an Engineering Certificate of Authorization. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LEGISLATIVE – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board was briefed on legislation that has been filed during the 2015 General Session. The staff will continue to monitor introduced legislation.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY – Mr. Earl Foust, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the initial results of the 2015 audit.

FINANCE – Mr. Richard Grace, Advisor

The financial reports for January, February, and March 2015 were reviewed.

An update on the status of hiring an additional employee responsible for public relation efforts was given. The Board was provided an explanation on the various staff positions and how their salaries were determined. Pay raises were approved and it was also directed that efforts should be started to seek an increase in the merit pay grade that Mr. Huett's position is assigned.

- 15-93. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Ms. Hyde to approve a 5% pay raise for Rick Huett. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-94. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Willis to approve a 5% pay raise for Regina Dinger. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-95. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Mr. Willis to start the process to request an increase in the merit pay grade for Rick Huett's position. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board was briefed on the upcoming travel. The Board determined who were going to be the NCEES funded delegates for the upcoming NCEES Annual Meeting.

- 15-96. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Grace that all Board Members, Executive Director, Assistant Executive Director, and Board Attorney be appointed as delegates to the Annual NCEES Meeting to be held in Williamsburg, VA on August 19-22, 2015; and further that Mr. Barter and Mr. Christy be designated as the funded delegates. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Changes to the previously adopted board calendar were discussed. Mr. Barter suggested that the Board might want to try starting the board meeting at 1:00 PM on the first day of a two-day meeting to allow the board members the possibility of being in their offices on each day of a board meeting instead of

having a very long one-day meeting. It was also discussed that dates for town hall meetings and at least one webinar date need to be set to discuss the proposed changes to the licensure law.

15-97. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Grace and seconded by Mr. Willis to adopt the changes to the board calendar as proposed. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board was briefed on Executive Order #16 in which Governor Bentley continued the existence of the Alabama Geographic Information Executive Council and the Advisory Committee to the Council. The Board identified that it wanted to continue being an active member of this Council.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Nathan Johnson, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the February 5, 2015 Board Meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

15-98. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the February 5, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

15-99. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board ratify the approval of Engineer Intern Certifications issued since the February 5, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

15-100. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board ratify the approval for examination those applicants approved since the February 5, 2015 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

- 15-101. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept for licensure as a professional engineer Mary Bordner Tanck, David Pierce Whitten Solberg, Eliborio Pena, and Paul Henri Durand. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-102. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board defers for licensure Jennifer Ann Johnson and Michael James Kraemer. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-103. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board denies for licensure Ryan Thomas Carter. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-104. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Willis that the Board approves John Francis Vincent, III, and Timothy Daniel Brooks to sit for the examination. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 15-105. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board denies for examination Austin Abiodun Dada and Rhett Phillip Sloan. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed a request for board evaluation of transcript from an applicant who wished to be considered for an exception to the application process due to the timing of the FE results. It was the Board's position that it was not going to rule on a hypothetical situation.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Board briefly discussed the issues of granting experience for construction engineering. It was agreed that further study was needed to identify what is or is not construction engineering. This study needs also to take into consideration the courses included in an ABET accredited construction engineering degree and the knowledge tasks included in the construction engineering PE discipline exam.

The agenda item on branch offices was not discussed since it was identified that the conflicts in the law and rules had been resolved with the proposed changes to the law and rules.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board discussed the status of the various merit positions. It was explained how raises were approved for merit positions and that those at the top of their merit pay grades could not be approved for any additional raises.

- 15-106. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Willis that it efforts should be made to see what can be done to move Bonnie Kelly into a higher series pay grade. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.



CLOSING REMARKS






