

**MINUTES OF FOURTH MEETING
2010-2011 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
May 19-20, 2011**

Chair Arnold called the fourth meeting of the 2010-2011 Board to order at 1:00 P.M., Thursday, May 19, 2011, at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

11-111. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the third meeting of the 2010-2011 Board held March 24-25, 2011 were received for approval.

11-112. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Santora that the minutes of the third meeting of the 2010-2011 Board held on March 24-25, 2011 be approved as amended. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Action items from previous meetings were reviewed and updated.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

11-113. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Misterys Arkle, Arnold, Foust, Santora, Ulrich, and Wilbanks and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Arnold announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 2:00 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was opened to the public at 1:50 P.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by Examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(4) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

11-114. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that the Board accept for licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY for all applicants other than Mr. Kulash. Mr. Arkle recused himself for the vote on Mr. Kulash.

11-115. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board accept for EI/LSI certification those applicants listed on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY for all applicants other than Mr. Demirbas. Mr. Foust recused himself for the vote on Mr. Demirbas.

11-116 IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board defers for licensure/certification Adrianus Vermeulen, Gary Ealey, Jerry Cox, Jr., Bruce Boan, and Scott Carney. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

11-117. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Dr. Turner to approve for examination those applicants listed on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

No vote was taken on Mr. Ernesto Cruz's application since his application had previously been deferred and the requirements identified by the Board had not been met.

FORMAL HEARINGS

At the request of Mr. Victor Sanderson, the Board conducted a formal hearing to render a decision on Mr. Sanderson's previously denied professional engineer licensure by examination application. The Board heard testimony from Mr. Sanderson and Mr. Walter Wickstrom. A court reporter was present and a transcript of the hearing is on file in the office.

11-118. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for the purpose of deliberating on Mr. Sanderson's request. Mistery Arkle, Arnold, Foust, Santora, Ulrich, and Wilbanks and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Arnold announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 3:15 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was opened to the public at 3:30 P.M.

11-119. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Santora to reaffirm the previous denial of Mr. Victor Sanderson's professional engineer licensure by examination application. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

The Board reviewed a request for board evaluation of transcripts from applicants who wished to be considered for licensure on the basis of obtaining non-engineering foreign degrees. It was noted that there is no provision in the Licensure Law to recognize foreign degrees that are not engineering degrees.

11-120. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that Hoonshin Jung's and Qiqi Liang's bachelors degrees be denied as they apply to engineer intern certification. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2011 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement action taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions. The licensees will be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files.

11-121. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that the enforcement actions taken by other licensing jurisdictions are made a part of the Alabama licensees' records and that the individuals are sent a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

11-122. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 10-41-B with a settlement agreement. The settlement agreement stipulates the professional land surveyor (respondent) will have his PLS license placed in retired status immediately, his PLS license cannot be returned to active status, and that this matter will not be a public record. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused.

11-123. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to close Case 11-11-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused.

11-124. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 11-21-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Santora recused.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisor

11-125. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4203-E through CA-4243-E issued since the March 24-25, 2011 Board Meeting and further that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

11-126. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board ratify the approval of Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-959-LS through CA-960-LS issued since the March 24-25, 2011 Board Meeting and further that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed the certificate of authorization applications that had anomalies.

11-127. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to approve the certificate of authorization applications for TAF Engineering Inc. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

11-128. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust to approve the certificate of authorization application for Construction Solutions International. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board discussed a request from Mr. Bruce V. Boan who was questioning if the firm Madison Industries in Conyers, GA was required to have a certificate of authorization. Mr. Boan is employed by Madison Industries which reportedly manufactures prefabricated modular buildings. Mr. Boan believes that their firm falls within the manufacturing exemption for a certificate of authorization. The Board disagreed. It was the Board's opinion that the company's web site shows that the firm is offering engineering as well as the providing of engineering buildings. The Board identified that if the modular building was to be erected in Alabama then the company was required to have an Alabama Certificate of Authorization and the work needed to be done under the supervision of an Alabama licensed professional engineer.

11-129. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arkle that Madison Industries required an Alabama certificate of authorization to perform Alabama projects. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board considered requests from Engineered Plastics of Alabama and GaN Corporation who were requesting extensions of deadlines that had been imposed for them to obtain certificates of authorization. In rendering their decision, the Board considered the number of months that the firms had been given to become compliant with the certification requirements.

11-130. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Dr. Turner to deny Engineered Plastics of Alabama's request for an extension and further instructed the staff to open a complaint. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

11-131. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arkle to deny GaN Corporation's request for an extension and further instructed the staff to open a complaint. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The meeting recessed at 5:00 P.M. The meeting reconvened at 8:00 A.M.

LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board was briefed on legislation being monitored in the 2011 General Session. The amendment to the board requested legislation was discussed. It was explained that the amendment introduced at the request of some of the utility companies was far reaching on its implications throughout the state. The Board determined that even though the changes to the licensure law being requested by the Board were important that they could not support the utility exemption amendment and instructed the Executive Director to contact Representative Wren, the bill sponsor, to ask that he not pursue bill passage.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY – Mr. Earl R. Foust, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the on-going audit for this year's renewal cycle. The Board was told that two cases were to be opened based on non-compliance.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

The Board met with Mr. John Pulice to discuss the Board's previous decision to disapprove his education as it applied to professional land surveyor licensure. The Board and Mr. Pulice discussed the lack of surveying core courses in his BS in Geography. The Board noted that it would not preapprove specific courses or course providers but they did outline the types of courses that meet the related to surveying core requirements.

FINANCE – Dr. Daniel S. Turner, Advisor

The financial reports for March and April were discussed. It was noted that the anticipated carryover was decreasing yearly. The staff was instructed to look at various cost saving measures including the possible deletion of the annual pocket cards.

The Board discussed and approved the proposed fees for FY 2012.

11-132. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Dr. Turner to submit the proposed changes to the fees as identified in **Attachment #5** to the Legislative Reference Office. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisor

The Board met with Mr. Patrick Olson and Mr. Andrew Beck of AeroMetric, Inc. who had requested to meet with the Board to discuss pending certificate of authorization application for AeroMetric, Inc.

The representatives of AeroMetric discussed the company's business operations. The Board explained the requirements for the principals to be present at the location offering the services and that the principal could be only at one location. The firm's representatives identified that they had considered opening an office in Huntsville, which is where Mr. Beck, P.L.S. was located. The Board identified that if the company resubmitted their application identifying the offering locations as what was discussed the certificate of authorization application would be approved.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. C. Michael Arnold, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the April 2011 exams.

11-133. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score for the DFLS and PLSA Examinations, to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination, to approve the results of the FLS, PLS, and ALLS Exams given April 2011, to license those individuals who passed the PLS and ALLS Exams having previously passed the FLS Exam and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board approved travel for the upcoming 2011 NCEES meeting.

11-134. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to authorize all board members, board executive director, assistant executive director, staff investigator, and board attorney to attend the 2011 NCEES Annual Meeting in Providence, RI, August 23-28, 2011 including travel dates, and to designate Mr. Arnold as the NCEES reimbursed delegate. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board approved travel to the CLEAR Annual Meeting.

11-135. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to authorize all board members, executive director, and assistant executive director be approved to attend the 2011 CLEAR Annual Conference in Pittsburgh, PA. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board approved travel to the FARB Attorney Forum.

11-136. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to authorize the executive director, assistant executive director, and paralegal be approved to attend the 2011 FARB Attorney Certification Seminar to be held September 29-October 2, 2011 in Park City, UT. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The proposed changes to the Colonial States Boards of Surveyor were briefed. It was noted that the organizational bylaws do not list Alabama as a member since the Alabama does not use the colonial states methodology for surveying. Alabama has been paying dues to the organization in order that in the event Alabama wants access to the organization's photogrammetry examination, it would be charged the membership rate. Since there is no movement to license photogrammetrists in Alabama, the Board identified that it was their intent to no longer participate in the Colonial States organization.

11-137. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors no longer participates as a member of the Colonial States Board of Surveyor. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Board was updated on the efforts ASPLS was making in responding to the Board's concerns about ASPLS' proposed language on the delaying of setting monumentation for subdivisions. ASPLS notified the Board that their practice committee was continuing to develop proposed changes to the Standards of Practice and that it was anticipated that those proposed changes were to be presented to the ASPLS Board of Directors. The Board offered a suggestion that it might be beneficial to have a dialogue between ASPLS and the Board about the proposed changes prior to the changes being voted on by the ASPLS membership.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed correspondence from an individual who was concerned about a degree being offered by the University of Alabama in Birmingham. The individual was concerned about statements made in advertisements that could be considered misleading and was also concerned that universities were offering masters programs in the schools of engineering that did not require the student to initially have a BS in Engineering. In order to further investigate the issue, the staff was instructed to open a complaint.

The Board was asked to render an opinion if a non-licensed individual could use the title "Test and Balance Engineer." It was noted that the Associated Air Balance Council (AABC) issues a certificate titled "Test and Balance Engineer" that authorizes an individual to perform total system balance in accordance with the standards as established by the AABC. It was noted that AABC does not require an individual to be a licensed PE prior to receiving the certification. The Board was concerned about the use of the title without being a licensed PE. In order to further investigate the issue, the staff was instructed to open a complaint.

The Board reviewed correspondence from Mr. George Surry, Fire Marshal for the City of Gulf Shores, who was asking for clarifications on the Board's Fire Sprinkler Position Statement. The questions were basically at what threshold necessitated the involvement of a professional engineer. The general opinion of the Board is that fire sprinkler system maintenance which involved only replacement-in-kind would not require the services of a professional engineer. If the maintenance could possibly alter the system then a professional engineer needed to be involved. To have a better understanding of the areas involved in fire sprinkler engineering, it was suggested that the Board continue to work with the State Fire Marshal and the item writers of the Fire Protection Engineering PE exam.

The Board reviewed various newsletters that required no response.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board approved the results of the FE Examination given April 2011.

11-138. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust to accept NCEES' recommended cutoff score and that the results of the Fundamentals of Engineering

Examination given April 9, 2011 be accepted, and further that the ABET graduates who have had transcripts furnished direct to the Board Office be approved for Engineer Intern certification and included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**.
MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board discussed the misunderstandings about industrial exemptions. It was noted that Alabama Licensure Law has an exemption for the certificate of authorization requirement for industry but not a licensing exemption. The Board discussed at what point do companies no longer fall under the CA exemption. It was decided that there is no clear answer and each case should be handled separately. It was noted that NCEES Presidents have identified that an effort needs to be done nationally to eliminate these types of exemptions in all of the jurisdictions. The Board agreed that there should be a national consensus on how to approach the elimination of various licensure exemptions.


OPEN FORUM

The next meeting of the Board for board business is scheduled for Monday, August 1, 2011 in Montgomery, Alabama.




