

**MINUTES OF FIFTH MEETING
2009-2010 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
May 19-20, 2010**

Chair Ulrich called the fifth meeting of the 2009-2010 Board to order at 1:00 P.M., Wednesday, May 19, 2010, at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present. Mr. Ulrich welcomed Mr. Foust to the Board. The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

10-162. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Tuner to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the fourth meeting of the 2009-2010 Board held March 25-26, 2010 were received for approval.

10-163. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the minutes of the fourth meeting of the 2009-2010 Board held on March 25-26, 2010 be approved as written. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Foust recused.

Action items from previous meetings were reviewed.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

10-164. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session

for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Misters Arnold, Foust, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Ulrich announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately one hour at 2:30 P.M. The meeting was closed to the public. The Executive Session was concluded and the Board reconvened in Open Session at 3:00 P.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by Examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(4) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

The Board recessed at 3:00 P.M. to have an informal meeting with members of the Department of Public Examiners and reconvened at 3:50 P.M.

10-165. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board accept for licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-166. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board accept for EI/LSI certification those applicants listed on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-167. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board defers for licensure/certification Eswar Burra, Surendrakumar Shah, Michael Fynn, Jeffrey Caviness, Charles Witcher, and Carl Ayubi. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-168. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-169. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board defers for examination those applicants listed as deferred on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2010 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement action taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions. The licensees will be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files.

10-170. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the enforcement actions taken by other licensing jurisdictions be made a part of the Alabama licensees' records. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

10-171. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 10-10-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-172. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner to close Case 10-21-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused.

10-173. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to close Case 10-23-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Dr. Turner recused.

10-174. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold that probable cause exists that Mr. Rodney Shiflett, PLS #21784, had performed a survey which contained errors and omissions. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Shiflett will pay the Board a \$1,500 fine, he will serve one year probation, he must attend a classroom Standard of Practice for Land Surveying in Alabama Course approved by the Board within six months of the final order, and that the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Dr. Turner recused. (Case 10-06-B)

10-175. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that probable cause exists that Mr. David L. Hesterlee, PE #26116, and his companies (Contour Inc. and Contour Design Company LLC) had provided and offered to provide engineering services in Alabama without obtaining engineering certificate of authorizations. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Hesterlee will pay the Board a \$1,500 fine, he will serve one year probation, he will cease and desist offering to provide or providing engineering services through his firms that have not obtained engineering

certificate of authorizations, and the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY. (Case 10-09-B)

10-176. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Foust that probable cause exists that Mr. Harold Pridgen, PE #9309, had applied his professional engineer seal and signature to mechanical, plumbing and electrical plans for a project in Alabama in violation of an opinion issued by the Board. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Pridgen will pay the Board a \$1,000 fine, he will surrender his Alabama Professional Engineer License, he will not apply for re-issuance of his Alabama Professional Engineer License for a period of five years after the date of the Final Order, and the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 08-41-B)

10-177. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust that probable cause exists that Mr. M. Don Williams, PE #11886, had submitted numerous structural design plans for homes in Alabama which were not in compliance with the wind load requirements adopted by the local commission. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Williams will pay the Board a \$5,000 fine; his PE license is suspended for 4 years with the suspension stayed; any submission of documents to an approving authority that contain the his signature and professional engineer seal during the stayed suspension period of his license that do not meet the acceptable standards of practice for engineering in Alabama, as determined by the Board, shall cause his license to be suspended for the time period remaining of the four year stayed suspension period; Mr. Williams must submit a current list of his clients to the Board prior to the seventh day of each month for twelve months commencing July 7, 2010; one client's name will be selected and Mr. Williams must provide a copy of the design drawings prepared for the identified client name to the Board for review; Mr. Williams must attend a Board approved continuing education course within six months of the date of the final order. This educational course cannot be utilized to meet the annual requirement of fifteen professional development hours for his professional engineer license renewal; and the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 09-287-B)

10-178. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 10-07-C with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Dr. Turner recused.

The meeting adjourned at 4:50 P.M. The meeting reconvened at 8:00 A.M., Thursday, May 20 at the Board office with all board members present with the exception of Mr. Arkle.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisor

10-179. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-3979-E through CA-4016-E issued since the March 25-26, 2010 Board Meeting and further that the list of

those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

- 10-180. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board ratify the approval of Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-921-LS through CA-922-LS issued since the March 25-26, 2010 Board Meeting and further that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed the certificate of authorization applications that had anomalies.

- 10-181. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust to approve certificates of authorizations for Kenroy Engineering Inc. and Christian Testing Laboratories, Inc. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

- 10-182. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to defer any action on Safe Span, LLC's certificate of authorization application until the firm receives a ruling from the Alabama Ethics Commission. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Arnold recused.

COMMUNICATIONS – Mr. William C. Ulrich, Jr., Advisor

The Board was briefed on the plans for the upcoming newsletter. Topics for inclusion in the newsletter were identified. The Board approved the concept of sending a post card notification identifying that the newsletter was available on the web site. Hard copies of the newsletter will be available on request. The staff will research how mass e-mail notifications can be used.

LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board was briefed on legislation being monitored during the 2010 Legislative General Session.

The Board discussed legislation that might be introduced during the 2011 General Session including changes to the Licensure Law. It was suggested to generalize the exam and fee requirements so there would not be a need to continually seek law changes when NCEES makes a change in the national exams. It was discussed if the Board should ask for the proposed changes to be included in the upcoming Sunset legislation.

- 10-183. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board will seek legislation once the best avenue is determined. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY –

The Board was briefed on progress of the audit for 2010 renewals.

The use statistics for the on-line Continuing Education Activity Log was briefed.

FINANCE/PERSONNEL – Dr. Dan Turner, Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisors

The reports on the receipts as well as expenditures were reviewed. It was noted that the anticipated carryover is lower than it has been in previous years. Expenses and receipts will be monitored.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. C. Michael Arnold., Advisor

The Board reviewed the requests from Mr. Jeffrey Wright and Mr. Kevin McMahon who asked for guidance on courses that would be acceptable for professional land surveying licensure. It was noted that the Board would not pre-approve any proposed curriculum. Mr. Wright was inquiring about an on-line program offered by Old Dominion University. The Board identified that it is hard to render a decision on distance education since it is difficult to determine course content. Mr. McMahon was inquiring if a course at East Tennessee State University would be accepted to meet the law and boundary course requirement. It was noted that the course content of the proposed course is similar to courses that the Board has previously approved.

ENGINEERING – Mr. William C. Ulrich, Jr., Advisor

Dr. Turner provided the Board a recap on ABET accreditation requirements. A comparison was made between the general ABET requirements and the evaluation criteria being drafted by NCEES for their use in evaluating foreign transcripts. Comments will be provided to NCEES encouraging them to develop criteria that is as close as it can be to the ABET criteria. NCEES should be encouraged to include ABET staff on the study team.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The Sunset Audit process was briefed. The times for the July Board meeting were adjusted to allow time for the Sunset Hearing scheduled for July 15th. The Board meeting will begin at 1:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 14th so that a disciplinary hearing can be scheduled for the 15th. Plans will be made to remain Friday if necessary to complete the board agenda.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board approved travel for the upcoming NCEES Annual Meeting.

10-184. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Dr. Turner to authorize all board members, board executive director, assistant director, and board attorney to attend the 2010 NCEES Annual Meeting in Denver, Colorado, August 17-22, 2010, and to designate Mr. Ulrich as the NCEES reimbursed delegate. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board approved travel for the 2010 CLEAR Annual Conference.

10-185. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to authorize all board members, board executive director, assistant director, and board attorney to attend the 2010 CLEAR Annual Conference including the executive leadership program and board member training in Nashville, Tennessee. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Dr. Turner abstaining.

The Board approved travel for the upcoming FARB Attorney Forum.

10-186. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust to authorize the board executive director, assistant director, paralegal and board attorney to attend the 2010 FARB Attorney Certification Seminar to be held September 30 – October 4 in Washington, D.C. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board was briefed on the planning efforts to host the 2012 Southern Zone Meeting in Huntsville.

10-187. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Embassy Suites in Huntsville be selected as the host hotel for the zone meeting. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board discussed the events that occurred at the 2010 Southern Zone Meeting regarding the question if the zone wanted to be involved in combined zone meetings.

10-188. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Southern Zone Vice President be requested to place on the agenda for the upcoming zone meeting an item to revisit the concept of participating in a joint zone meeting. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The recommendation to NCEES of Mr. Al Reisz's appointment for emeritus status was approved.

10-189. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arnold to recommend to NCEES Mr. Al Reisz for emeritus status. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Board was updated on the efforts to revise the Administrative Code. Board staff will continue with the drafting process.

The Board was provided a recap on federal statutes involving services on federal property. Mr. Albritton, board attorney, identified that he did not believe there was a conflict between the cited cases and the Board's licensure law. The difference appears to be individuals serving as contractors on federal property vs. contracted federal employees. Based on the discussion, the Board decided that they would proceed as previously proposed.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Phillip Gibson who had requested a declaratory opinion if

three individuals who all have certification of authorizations form a joint venture, does that venture also require a certificate of authorization.

10-190. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust that the joint venture also required a certificate of authorization. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Victor Long who was asking that his April 2010 Fundamentals of Examination fee be rolled to the October 2010 FE offering due to a death of an immediate relative. It was noted that an obligation had been incurred for the entire fee Mr. Long had already paid whether he sat for the exam or not.

10-191. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to disapprove the request to roll the exam fee but approve that Mr. Long be considered as an initial applicant instead of a repeat applicant for the October 2010 exam. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed a letter from Mr. Keith Bryant, Alabama Power Company, who was requesting the Board's opinion if an Alabama licensed professional land surveyor could sign/seal the Exhibit G drawings that are required by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) even though the PLS may not have been directly supervised the preparation of the drawings. It was the Board's opinion that the signing of the drawings by a PLS was not in violation of the Code of Ethics if there was a proper disclaimer similar to the sample shown in the FERC Guidelines. The Board recognizes that the drawings are not a property boundary survey as normally defined. The drawings must be sealed by a PLS, the PLS must verify the accuracy of the map, and the drawings must have the proper disclaimer.

10-192. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Dr. Turner that a letter be sent to Mr. Bryant outlining the Board's opinion as outlined above. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed correspondence received asking for clarification of the Board's Fire Protection Policy Statement. The Board was briefed on the discussions that the Board staff has had with various individuals and the State Fire Marshal. The Board reviewed the procedures instituted by the City of Tuscaloosa and concurred that they met the intent of the policy statement.

The Board reviewed various newsletters that required no response.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board reviewed suggested courses to determine what type of course would be required to meet the requirements of the signed consent order. (See Motion 10-177.) Based on the reviews provided by the technical advisor, various courses whose course content involved coastal wind loads on structures were recommended.

10-193. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Santora that any of the four courses recommended or a comparable course would meet the requirement as identified in the agreed upon consent order. Mr. Williams will need to provide the

course description to the Board for their review prior to the taking of the specific course. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused. (Case 09-287-B)


OPEN FORUM

The next meeting of the Board for board business is scheduled for Wednesday, July 14, 2010 in Montgomery, Alabama beginning at 1:00 P.M.




