

**MINUTES OF SIXTH MEETING
2011-2012 BOARD OF LICENSURE

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

12-151. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Minutes of the fifth meeting of the 2011-2012 Board held May 17, 2012 were received for approval.

12-152. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner that the minutes of the fifth meeting of the 2011-2012 Board held on May 17, 2012 be approved as written. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for

Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

12-153. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board accept for licensure by comity those applicants listed on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

12-154. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2011 - 2012 statistics.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

12-155. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner that probable cause exists that Mr. Randy Arp, PE #24556, had provided expert witness and technical testimony outside of his area of experience, training and knowledge and further that the testimony contained violations of the acceptable practice of engineering in Alabama. The accepted terms of the consent order are that Mr. Arp must complete the ten-hour course in Engineering Ethics provided by the Murdough Center of Texas Tech University within six months of the date of the Final Order, his professional engineer's license will be suspended for two years with the suspension being stayed commencing with the date of the Final Order, Mr. Arp will pay a \$2,000 fine to the Board within 30 days of the Final Order, he must submit a list of clients to the Board each month for 12 months commencing 30 days of the Final Order, he must submit for Board review the design drawings of a Board selected client, and the matter will become a public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Mr. Barter voting in the negative and Mr. Arnold recused. (Case 11-38-B)

12-156. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora to close Case 12-09-C with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Willis recused.

12-157. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Dr. Turner to close Case 12-18-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Willis and Mr. Arnold recused.

12-158. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Willis and seconded by Mr. Santora that probable cause exists that Mr. Gerald Ross Martin, PLS #13191, had failed to comply with a

Mississippi Board investigation which resulted in his MS PLS licensed being revoked. The proposed terms of the consent order are that Mr. Martin will serve two years probation, he will pay \$156.92 to the Board for the cost of the investigation, he must complete the University of New Mexico Ethics for Surveyors Course within 6 months of the Final Order, and that the matter will become a public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 6-0 with Mr. Arnold recused. (Case 12-08-B)

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

12-159. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4431-E through CA-4449-E and Surveying Certificate of Authorization CA-990-S issued since the May 17, 2012 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed the certificate of authorization application that had anomalies. It was the Board's decision that Mr. Pearnell Wilson will have to meet the Board to discuss what engineering services are being offered and performed by ABSI LLC and Milan Grace LLC.

12-160. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora to defer the certificate of authorization renewal application for ABSI LLC. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

ENGINEERING – Mr. Charles P. Willis., Advisor

The board approved the April PE Examination results.

12-161. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Dr. Turner to accept the NCEES' recommended cutoff score and that the results of the Principles and Practice of Engineering Examination given April 13, 2012 be accepted, and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing this examination be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

NEW BUSINESS

Prior to discussing the proposed changes to the Administrative Code, the Board discussed the new agenda item.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Fred Malicoat, PE, who was requesting the Board determine whether he could seal multiple discipline engineering drawings. It was noted that licensees should only practice ~~in~~ those areas in which they are competent. The Board could not identify that Mr. Malicoat was not competent to offer the multiple disciplines.

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12-162. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Willis that a letter be sent to Mr. Malicoat identifying that it his responsibility to practice in only those areas in which he is competent to do so. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CHAIR'S REPORT

The Board considered the previously proposed changes to the Administrative Code. Each chapter of the Administrative Code was discussed taking into consideration the comments that had been received when the proposed changes were distributed to the licensees.
