

**MINUTES OF SEVENTH MEETING
2009-2010 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
September 16-17, 2010**

Chair Ulrich called the seventh meeting of the 2009-2010 Board to order at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, September 16, 2010, at the Board office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present.

FORMAL HEARING

A formal disciplinary hearing was convened at 10:05 A.M. to hear testimony concerning a complaint against Mr. O. Guthrie Jeffcoat, Jr., P.E. #9587, for failing to provide certification documentation in a timely manner. Mr. Jeffcoat was represented by Mr. Berney Brannon. A court report was present and a transcript of this proceeding was requested. (Case 09-305-B)

Ms. Dana Billingsley, administrative law judge, presided at the hearing. Mr. Ulrich, Mr. Arnold, Mr. Santora, Mr. Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner heard evidence presented by Assistant Attorney General Mr. Benjamin Albritton. Mr. Arkle and Mr. Foust were recused. The hearing concluded at 3:45 P.M.

Dr. Turner left the meeting for a previous scheduled engagement.

10-229. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Ulrich to defer deliberating on the hearing until such time as the administrative law judge provides her facts findings, and recommendations on the case. MOTION CARRIED 4-0 with Dr. Turner being absent and Mr. Arkle and Mr. Foust recused.

The meeting adjourned at 4:15 P.M.

The meeting reconvened at 8:00 A.M., Friday, September 17, 2010 at the board office. Mr. Arkle was present. Dr. Turner and Mr. Albritton were absent.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed. The new agenda items were briefed.

10-230. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to adopt the revised agenda. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Minutes of the sixth meeting of the 2009-2010 Board held July 15-16, 2010 were received for approval.

10-231. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust that the minutes of the sixth meeting of the 2009-2010 Board held on July 15-16, 2010 be approved as amended. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Action items from previous meetings were reviewed.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board reviewed the list of those completed cases that are being monitored. The Board was briefed on the 2010 statistics.

The Board reviewed enforcement action taken against Alabama licensees by other licensing jurisdictions. The licensees will be notified that copies of the actions will be placed in their Alabama licensing files.

10-232. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Foust that the enforcement actions taken by other licensing jurisdictions be made a part of the Alabama licensees' records and that the individuals be sent a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action.

10-233. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust that probable cause exists that Mr. David Alan Fuqua, PE #16915, and his firm Terra Form Inc. had been providing or offering to provide engineering services in Alabama without obtaining a Certificate of Authorization for engineering as well as continuing to provide services once the certificate was in lapsed status. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Fuqua shall pay the Board a \$1,000 fine, he will serve one year probation and that the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Arkle recused. (Case 10-19-B)

10-234. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that probable cause exists that Mr. Thomas Martinez, PE #21239, had provided a check for payment of his licensure renewal that had been dishonored by the bank and had failed to respond to

tender payment. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Martinez shall pay the Board a \$250 fine, his professional engineer's license will not be returned to active status until he provides the \$70.00 payment for the dishonored check and service charge, he will serve six months probation and that the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Santora recused. (Case 10-24-B)

- 10-235. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 10-31-B with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Arnold recused.
- 10-236. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora to close Case 10-32-B with no further action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Wilbanks recused.
- 10-237. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arnold that probable cause exists that Ms. Courtney A. Rice, an FE exam applicant, had obtained answers to the examination questions by looking at the scantron answer sheet of another exam applicant seated to her right. She advised once she observed the answer, she would change her answer to match the answer on the answer sheet of the other candidate. The proposed terms of the consent order are Ms. Rice is not eligible to take the FE exam for one year; she will complete the 3 pdh course on ethics in engineering provided by the Murdough Center for Engineering Ethics of Texas Tech University and that the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Foust recused. (Case 10-34-C)
- 10-238. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 10-36-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused.
- 10-239. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Santora to close Case 10-37-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 10-240. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust to close Case 10-39-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Arkle recused.
- 10-241. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that probable cause exists that Mr. Steven A. Oliver, an unlicensed individual, had held himself to be a professional engineer in Alabama without obtaining a valid professional engineer's license from the Board. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Oliver will pay a \$500 civil penalty to the General Fund of Alabama, he will reimburse \$126.59 to the Board for the cost of the investigation, he will cease and desist using the title of licensed professional engineer until he obtains a professional engineer license from the Board and that the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Arkle recused. (Case 10-29-C)
- 10-242. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Foust that probable cause exists that Mr. Keith O'Neal Walsh, P.E. #11174, was associated with the practice of engineering during the time his license to practice engineering was in "inactive" status

by verifying engineering experience for an applicant to take the principles and practice of engineering examination. Further that his employer, J. H. Wright and Associates Inc., may have offered or performed the practice of engineering without obtaining a certificate of authorization. The proposed terms of the consent order are Mr. Walsh will pay a \$1,000 fine to the Board, he will serve one year probation, J. H. Wright and Associates Inc. will reimburse \$649.93 to the Board for the cost of the investigation, the firm will cease and desist the offering/performing of engineering, the firm will remove the title "engineer" or any modifications of derivatives thereof from its advertising and correspondence until such time as it obtains a certificate of authorization from the Board and that the record of this matter will be a matter of public record. The Board accepted the terms of the consent order and issued the final order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Ulrich recused. (Case 09-322-B)

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisor

10-243. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board ratify the approval of Engineering Certificates of Authorization CA-4048-E through CA-4080-E and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization CA-929-LS through CA-933-LS issued since the July 15-16, 2010 Board Meeting and further that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed the certificate of authorization applications that had anomalies.

10-244. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to approve those certificates of authorizations as listed on **Attachment #5**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Dr. Turner and Mr. Bill Garrett, assistant Attorney General, arrived for the meeting.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Phillip E. Santora, Advisor

10-245. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors go into Executive Session for one hour for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Mistrs Arkle, Arnold, Foust, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Ulrich announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 11:00 A.M. Mr. Garrett certified that there was a valid justification for the executive session. The meeting was closed to the public. The Executive Session was extended to continue to discuss pending applications.

10-246. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arnold to extend the executive session for one hour for the purpose of discussing pending applications. Mistrs Arkle, Arnold, Foust, Santora, Ulrich, Wilbanks, and Dr. Turner voted in favor of the motion.

Chair Ulrich announced the Board would reconvene into open session at approximately 1:00 P.M. Mr. Garrett certified that there was a valid justification for the executive session. The Executive Session was concluded and the Board reconvened in Open Session at 1:00 P.M.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by Examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(4) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

- 10-247. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board accept for licensure by comity with an effective date of October 1, 2010 those applicants listed on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 10-248. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Foust that the Board accept for EI/LSI certification with an effective date of October 1, 2010 those applicants listed on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 10-249. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Ulrich and seconded by Mr. Arkle that the Board defers for licensure/certification Thomas Roeder, Jr., Ward Arms, Joshua Royce, Robert Patrick, III, Johnny Sims, Rogelio de Jesus del Sol, Bhautik Patel, and Julio Cesar Garcia. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 10-250. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board denies for licensure Thomas Meyer. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 10-251. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that the Board approves for examination those applicants listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
- 10-252. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board defers for examination those applicants listed as deferred on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

10-253. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Dr. Turner that the Board denies for examination those applicants listed as denied on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

The Board reviewed requests for board evaluation of transcripts from applicants who wished to be considered for licensure on the basis of obtaining a related science degree or a foreign degree.

10-254. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks that Susan Carol Hill's education be approved as a graduate of an unaccredited curriculum as it applies to engineering applications; that Jason Dearman's education be approved as a graduate of a related science curriculum as it applies to surveying applications; and John Marcus Graham's education be approved as a graduate of a related to surveying curriculum as it applies to surveying applications. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mr. Garrett left the meeting.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. Benjamin Browning who was asking that a proposed mentoring program between him and Mr. John Bertalan be approved. Mr. Browning was requesting the Board to approve Mr. Bertalan as a mentor in order that he could verify Mr. Browning's engineering experience as it applies to a professional engineer application. The Board accepted the proposed mentoring program for future engineering experience but not for experience prior to the approval of the program.

FINANCE/PERSONNEL – Dr. Dan Turner, Mr. Don T. Arkle, Advisors

The reports on the receipts as well as expenditures were reviewed.

The Board was briefed on the costs of the new 16-hour structural exam. The Board discussed possible changes to the Administrative Code which would increase professional application fees by \$25 and the cost of the PE exam by \$20. The fee increase will help defray the cost of the new structural exam until such time as legislative relief can be obtained. During the discussion of the fee increase, it was requested that the staff provide a 5-year recap on revenues and expenditures.

10-255. IT WAS MOVED by Dr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Foust to submit the proposed changes to the legislative reference office. MOTION CARRIED 6-1 with Mr. Santora voting in the negative.

Dr. Turner left the meeting to attend a previous scheduled meeting.

Concerns were identified about other applicants subsidizing the applicants who seek to take the structural exam and especially those who are not Alabama residents. The Board discussed the possibility of seeking an opinion if the two sections of the structural exam could be considered as two exams for fee purposes.

10-256. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Wilbanks to seek an Attorney General opinion if the Structural Exam can be considered as two separate exams for fee purposes. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

LEGISLATIVE – Mr. W. Gerald Wilbanks, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the 2011 Legislative General Session calendar. The Sunset process was briefed. The Board determined it would submit separate legislation from the Sunset legislation. The Board reviewed possible changes to the Licensure Law. Efforts to draft legislation will continue at the December board meeting.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY – Mr. Earl Foust, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the problems some of the licensees are having with continuing education providers providing misleading information. It was explained that the licensee lists are public records and that the board office has to provide those lists to the providers. The message that is sent with the lists that tells the providers not to use any language that would infer that the course or course provider is Alabama approved was strengthened.

ENGINEERING – Mr. William C. Ulrich, Jr., Advisor

The Board discussed the possibility of having a joint meeting with the engineering deans. Possible topics of discussion were identified. The executive director will contact Dean Steadman to assist with the planning of the meeting.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Mr. Ulrich commented on the letter he received from Mr. Gregory Spies, P.L.S., who was commenting on the lack of responses from the board. Mr. Ulrich will respond to Mr. Spies acknowledging the letter.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board approved the 2011 board meeting calendar.

10-257. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Foust to adopt the proposed 2011 Board Meeting Calendar. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board reviewed the agenda for the October 2010 meeting of the Colonial States Boards of Surveyors. It was determined that no one from the Board would attend.

The Board was briefed on the call from NCEES for the 2011 NCEES National Awards.

10-258. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Ulrich that the Board will submit Mr. Rick Huett for the meritorious service award. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Travel to the various NCEES committee meetings was approved.

10-259. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arkle and seconded by Mr. Arnold that any board member or board staff who is a NCEES committee member be approved to attend the respective NCEES committee meeting. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Travel to the 2011 CLEAR Business Meeting was approved.

10-260. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Santora and seconded by Mr. Arnold that the executive director be approved to attend the 2011 CLEAR Business Meeting to be held in Albuquerque, NM. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Travel to the 2011 FARB Annual Conference was approved.

10-261. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Wilbanks and seconded by Mr. Santora that all board members, the executive director, the assistant executive director, and board attorney be approved to attend the 2011 Annual FARB meeting to be held in New Orleans, LA. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed requests from Engineered Maintenance Services and Engineered Plastics of Alabama who were requesting they be allowed to use the term "Engineered" in their company titles without obtaining a certificate of authorization.

10-262. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Arnold and seconded by Mr. Arkle to disapprove both requests but give both firms six months to become compliant. MOTION CARRIED 5-0-1 with Mr. Wilbanks abstaining.

The Board was updated on the efforts the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board were undertaking in investigating the Deepwater Horizon accident. NCEES and interested jurisdictions are sharing information regarding this particular incident, licensing exemptions, and federal drilling requirements. Mr. Ulrich and Ms. Dinger were identified to be the focal points for Alabama.

The Board reviewed a request from the Jefferson County Environmental Services Department who was seeking an opinion if a proposed scope of work which called for the use GPS or conventional surveying techniques to locate the sanitary sewer manholes constituted the practice of engineering or land surveying. It was the Board's opinion that either engineers or land surveyors could be qualified to do the type of work described. If engineers or land surveyors were used then a qualification based selection process would be required.

Mr. Wilbanks left the meeting. A quorum of 5 board members remained.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. John Crawford, P.E. who posed various questions to the board regarding requirements and responsibilities for the head of a municipal engineering or architectural department. Most of the questions posed dealt with liability issues and were determined to be outside of the Board's authority to render a decision and should be referred to the city attorney. As to the question whether an unlicensed individual could hire the professional engineers, it was the board opinion that there is not a problem with an unlicensed individual being the department head.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. John Wade, P.E., who was requesting an opinion if based on his education and background could he submit life safety and passive fire protection designs without the involvement of an architect. The Board deferred the decision to the Board of Architects since it was believed that the project dealt with incidental practice of architecture by an engineer.

The Board reviewed a request from Mr. John Hicks, P.L.S., who was requesting an opinion if a water authority can dictate which engineering company must be used when designing an addition to that authority's water system. It was the Board's opinion that Mr. Hicks was asking a legal question that should be posed either to the legal office of the water authority or the Attorney General.

The Board reviewed various newsletters that required no response.

NEW BUSINESS

The Board approved the contract with NCEES for exam administration.

10-263. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Foust and seconded by Mr. Santora that the Board approves the proposed contract with NCEES for January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012. MOTION CARRIED 5-0.

OPEN FORUM

No comments were received during the open forum portion of the meeting.

CLOSING REMARKS

The next meeting of the Board for board business is scheduled for Thursday, December 2, 2010 in Montgomery, Alabama beginning at 8:00 A.M.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 4:55 P.M.


