

**MINUTES OF SIXTH MEETING
2014-2015 BOARD OF LICENSURE
FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
Montgomery, Alabama
September 24-25, 2015**

Acting Chair Barter called the sixth meeting of the 2014-2015 Board to order at 1:00 P.M., Thursday, September 24, 2015 at the at the Board Office in Montgomery, Alabama. The following were in attendance:

It was determined that a quorum was present. The meeting was opened with a prayer.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed.

15-158. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to adopt the proposed agenda. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Minutes of the fifth meeting of the 2014-2015 Board were received for approval.

15-159. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy that the minutes of the fifth meeting of the 2014-2015 Board held July 29-30, 2015 be approved as written. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Action items from previous board meetings were reviewed.

HEARINGS

Mr. Austin Dada had filed a request for a hearing before the Board in regards to his previously denied professional engineer by examination licensure application. A hearing regarding the application was conducted and a court reporter was present in order to prepare a transcript of the proceedings.

15-160. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board go into executive session for deliberations on the denied application hearing. Mr. Barter, Mr. Christy, Mr. Grace, Ms. Hyde, Mr. Johnson, and Mr. Whorton voted in favor of the motion. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Mr. Barter announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately 20 minutes. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was reopened at 2:15 P.M.

15-161. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy to approve Mr. Dada's professional engineering application. MOTION CARRIED 3-2-1 with Mr. Johnson and Mr. Grace voting in the negative and Mr. Whorton abstaining.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

To allow for a public comment period during the meeting, the Board agreed to discuss the subject of Quality Based Selection (QBS) next. Mr. Jeff Lucas, P.L.S., President of ASPLS addressed the Board with ASPLS's concerns about the recent letter that was sent to all licensees. The letter was the Board's method to educate all licensees about the requirement to follow the QBS process when responding to requests for work. Mr. Lucas raised the same concerns that he had previously addressed to the Board about the difficulty that practicing land surveyors have in explaining the QBS process to individual land owners who only want to know what it is going to cost to have their property surveyed. Mr. Lucas identified differences in the Federal Brooks Act and the threshold limits identified in Alabama's procurement laws. It was his contention that licensed surveyors deal more with the public than licensed engineers and that individual property owners do not want to discuss qualifications. It was also Mr. Lucas's contention that with QBS being located in the Board's Code of Ethics (Administrative Rules) that it requires the practitioners to enforce the requirement instead of being able to take action on the person/entity that is asking for the bid. Mr. Lucas concluded his remarks by identifying that ASPLS had authorized him to present various requests for the Board to consider to change the QBS paragraph. The first option was to exempt from QBS all projects less than \$15,000.

Mr. Barter identified that he agreed there was a big difference between engineering and land surveying work but that he thought \$15,000 was a very large project. He believed that there should not be any exemption for engineering work and acknowledged that the Board understood that there may be a problem with the small boundary survey. Mr. Christy identified that he did not agree with the \$15,000 threshold, that he was not aware of any type of threshold in the Brooks Act, but that he agrees that there is a problem. Mr. Christy identified that he would like the Board to hold off in making any decisions on ASPLS' request until such time as the surveying task force completed their work.

Mr. Albritton, Board Attorney, suggested the Board go into executive session to discuss possible legal matters. Prior to making the motion, Mr. Jason Bailey, P.L.S. made a few short comments to the Board

showing the sense of urgency from the small business owner's perspective. In trying to be compliant with QBS he believes that he has lost at least 5-7 jobs because of property owners hanging up on him when he tried to explain his qualifications instead of quoting them a price for their surveys.

15-162. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to go into executive session to discuss a controversy not currently being litigated but that could likely be litigated. Mr. Barter, Mr. Christy, Mr. Grace, Ms. Hyde, Mr. Johnson, and Mr. Whorton voted in favor of the motion. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Mr. Barter announced the Board would reconvene into open session in approximately 30 minutes. Mr. Albritton, Board Attorney verified that this was a legitimate reason to go into executive session. The meeting was closed to the public. The meeting was reopened at 3:40 P.M.

Mr. Barter identified to the public present that the Board had listened to the surveyors' concerns, but he believed that the Board had not changed their opinion on not suggesting a rule change with included a \$15,000 exemption threshold for both engineering and land surveying work. Mr. Lucas then asked if the Board would consider that threshold for only surveying work. The Board did not agree with that proposal either but Mr. Barter instructed Mr. Christy to call an emergency meeting of the task force to see if they could draft some recommended language and have it ready prior to the November board meeting.

There being no further public comments the Board resumed the original agenda.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Nathan Johnson, Advisor

The Board previously authorized Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. All applications for licensure, intern certification and examinations issued since the July 29-30, 2015 Board Meeting were reviewed.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a. and b. of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Engineer Intern certification, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Land Surveyor licensure by examination, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a., b., and c. of the Licensure Law, were considered. Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure by examination having previously passed the Fundamentals of Land Surveying Examination and the Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction were considered and were approved for the Alabama Land Surveying Standards, History, and Law Examination.

- 15-163. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board ratify the approval of licenses issued since the July 29-30, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-164. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson that the Board ratify the approval of Engineer Intern Certifications issued since the July 29-30, 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #2**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-165. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board ratify the approval for examination those applicants approved since the July 29-30, 2015 meeting and listed as approved on **Attachment #3**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-166. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board accepts for licensure by comity James G. Hall. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-167. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde that the Board defers for licensure Thomas E. Emerson and Matthew G. Bell. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-168. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board denies for licensure Mark Thomas Kilgore and Alexander Orman. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-169. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Christy that the Board approves Kenneth Laurence Erdoes, Jr. and Arthur Palosz to sit for the examination. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.
- 15-170. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board denies Billy Alex McConathy to sit for the examination. MOTION CARRIED 5-0-1 with Mr. Christy abstaining.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board reviewed the status of the files pending with the Board, the Investigator, and/or the Investigative Committee. The Board was briefed on the 2014-2015 statistics. There was a discussion about the time it was taking the investigative committee to make a decision as to whether there was probable cause to proceed on a few cases. Everyone was reminded that the goal that had been agreed upon was that the members of the investigative committee would have their inputs on an open case to the rest of the members of the investigative committee within 30 days of the case being sent out for review. The Board identified possible dates for the postponed July 2015 disciplinary hearing. Due to the number of witnesses, the case will still be heard in either Mobile or the Gulf Shores area. Two possible dates in January were identified. The final date will be based on discussions with the attorneys involved and the ALJ.

The Board reviewed pending cases that the investigative committees have completed to accept, modify, or reject the suggested courses of action. Cases that are being recommended for closure or where they are recommendations from the investigative committee are discussed in a sanitized format so that in the event the Board suggests another course of action that the due process of the investigation has not been

compromised. Respondent's information is not divulged until after a proposed consent order is accepted and a final order is approved. Prior to the discussion of Case 2014-18-B Mr. Christy left the room and did not return until the vote had been taken on that particular case.

- 15-171. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson to close Case 2014-18-B with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 4-0 with Mr. Barter and Mr. Christy recused.
- 15-172. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Barter and seconded by Ms. Hyde to close Case 2014-20-B with a letter of caution. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Christy recused.
- 15-173. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and Mr. Johnson to close Case 2014-30-B with a letter of reprimand. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-174. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed consent order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-07-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Michael W. Solitro, PLS #32129 had produced a survey that contained violations of the standards of practice for land surveying in Alabama. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Solitro will pay a \$500 fine and the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 15-175. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Christy to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-09-B. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. James Grey Joyce, PE #22248, had failed to provide the necessary documents during the 2014 renewal audit to show that he had obtained the necessary professional development hours necessary to renew. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that Mr. Joyce will pay a \$500 fine, he will need to obtain 10 pdh to replace the course he reported on his license renewal application that did not meet the Board's criteria for professional development and the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-176. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Cases 2015-12-C, 2015-17-C, 2015-23-C, and 2015-24-C. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Gerry Hooper, an unlicensed individual and his firm, Pinnacle Home Inspections, had represented that he was a licensed structural engineer without being licensed as a professional engineer in Alabama when he offered or completed numerous structural inspections on private residences. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that he will pay a \$6,688.75 civil penalty to the State General Fund, he will pay \$811.25 to the Board for the cost of the investigations, he will cease and desist identifying himself in any media as a professional engineer and the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Christy recused.

- 15-177. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-22-C. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. William Gordin Hayes, EI and owner of Alabama Roof Engineers, had allowed the term "Engineers" in the firm's title without first obtaining a certificate of authorization from the Board. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that a \$2,000 civil penalty be paid to the Alabama General Fund and that the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-178. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-30-C. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Jay Jenkins, an unlicensed individual had offered and performed engineering when he produced a report that included structural stability conclusions and a general plan of repair on a private residence. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that he will pay \$725 civil penalty to the Alabama General Fund, \$275 to the Board for the cost of the investigation, he agrees to cease and desist the practice of engineering in Alabama until such time as he receives a license to practice engineering from the Board, and the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Ms. Hyde recused.
- 15-179. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to accept the proposed Consent Order and issue the Final Order for Case 2015-35-C. It was determined that there was probable cause that Mr. Robert Dryden, an unlicensed individual, advertised that he was a structural engineer. The accepted terms of the Consent Order are that he will pay \$1,500 civil penalty to the Alabama General Fund, he agrees to cease and desist identifying himself as a structural engineer or a professional engineer until such time as he obtains the required license, and the Consent Order and Final Order will become a public record. The Board accepted the Consent Order and issued the Final Order. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.
- 15-180. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to close Case 2015-40-C with no action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Grace recused.
- 15-181. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace to close Case 2015-43-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Johnson recused.
- 15-182. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to close Case 2015-47-B with no action. MOTION CARRIED 5-0 with Mr. Barter recused.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:25 P.M. The meeting was reconvened at 8:00 A.M. on September 25, 2015 with the same board members present.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. Marc S. Barter, Advisor

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of the certificate of authorizations issued since the July 2015 Board Meeting were reviewed.

- 15-183. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Grace that the Board ratify the approval of the Engineering and Land Surveying Certificates of Authorization issued since the July 2015 Board Meeting and that the list of those issued be included in the minutes on **Attachment #4**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

The Board had a discussion about which Certificates of Authorization with exceptions should come before the Board. It was determined to continue to review all those that had exceptions. The Board then discussed the specific applications before the Board.

- 15-184. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to approve the applications for Wise Engineering Center LLC, Forward Consulting Inc., and Clinkscales Land Surveying LLC. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

- 15-185. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Mr. Johnson to approve the application for LK&A Inc. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

LEGISLATIVE – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

The Board was briefed on legislation that had been filed during the 2015 Special Session #2. The Governor called the special session to pass the General Fund Budget.

Discussion on the proposed changes to the Licensure Law was moved to the end of the meeting.

FINANCE – Mr. Richard Grace, Advisor

The financial reports for July and August 2015 were reviewed. Possible changes in revenues and expenses for FY2016 were briefed. The Board determined that it would continue to use the Attorney General's Office for legal support even though it was anticipated that the billing amount would change.

PERSONNEL – Mr. Marc Barter, Advisor

It was explained that the staff who fill merit positions received annual appraisals and that there have never been appraisals done for the executive and deputy directors' positions. It was the consensus of the Board that there should be appraisals done on all staff personnel. The Executive Director will be responsible for completing the appraisal on the Deputy Director and the Executive Assistant and the Board Chair will complete the appraisal on the Executive Director.

LAND SURVEYING – Mr. Frazier Christy, Advisor

The Board approved the results of the Alabama State Specific Surveying Examination given August 2015.

- 15-186. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Hyde and seconded by Mr. Johnson to accept to accept the Board's recommended cutoff score for the ALLS Examination, to approve the results of the ALLS Exam given August 28, 2015, to license the individuals who passed the ALLS Exam having previously passed the FLS and PLS Exams and further that the list of those issued licensure as a result of passing these examinations be included in the minutes on **Attachment #1**. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

Mr. Christy identified a concern he has about a brochure that he recently received from a continuing education provider and the quality of that education. His concerns are about the quality of the education since some of the sample questions have incorrect answers and the amount of hours being awarded at completion of the course. It was explained that even though courses and course providers are not preapproved that if it comes to the attention of the board that courses are questionable, the Board has intervened in the past. The Executive Director was instructed to notify the continuing education provider of the Board's concerns.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Upcoming in-state and out-of-state travel was discussed. The value gained by paying for booth registrations at the various society meetings was discussed. The Board voiced their concern over the increasing cost of vendor space and felt that more participants could be reached if the Board was given actual time on the program to make a presentation to the attendees. It was the decision of the Board that Board approval will be required to pay for vendor space at the engineering and surveying society meetings.

The Board approved the resubmission of Mr. Gerald Wilbanks for the NCEES Distinguished Service Award. The Executive Director will update this year's submission package and resubmit it to NCEES for their consideration.

The Board reviewed the renewal procedures for the upcoming renewal cycle and the communications received in the office about individuals still wanting a paper renewal. The staff was instructed that unless it was a hardship case all individuals are to use the on-line renewal system. The Board gave the board staff the authority to approve hardship cases without them being presented to the Board.

The proposed meeting dates for 2016 were discussed. Other travel for 2016 was also reviewed. It was noted that the Board believed that the Board should fund a table at the Engineering Hall of Fame dinner as it is a function of the Board to encourage licensure and to interact with the state's engineering community. The Executive Director will check as to what approval is needed from the Comptroller's office.

- 15-187. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Christy and seconded by Ms. Hyde to adopt the proposed 2016 Board Meeting Calendar. MOTION CARRIED 6-0.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board considered a request from Mr. Keith Maxwell who was asking if the online marketing process he is using code be considered as being in violation of the Board's Code of Ethics. It was the Board's opinion that if Mr. Maxwell was paid a flat fee then that was the same as paying for advertisement and was not in violation of the Code of Ethics. If Mr. Maxwell is paid a percentage of the work found for his client then it is the Board's opinion that he would be in violation of the Code of Ethics. The difference in the two scenarios is that in the first scenario it is anticipated that work is going to be obtained where as in the second scenario it could be construed that the engineer or land surveyor who obtains the work is promise to pay a commission for work.

OPEN FORUM

No additional comments made during the open forum.

LEGISLATIVE – Ms. M. Elisabeth Hyde, Advisor

With all other business before the Board concluded, the Board discussed the proposed law changes and the comments received either as a result of the town hall meetings held throughout the state or the webinars that had been held. Discussions were at the concept level not on actual language. Once the concepts were addressed, the Executive Director was instructed to provide an updated version of the draft. The individuals who have provided comments will be notified of the Board's decisions.
