

**ALABAMA BOARD OF LICENSURE FOR
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS
MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 20, 2022
Montgomery, Alabama**

The Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was established by legislative action in 1935. Its charter is to protect the public by helping to safeguard life, health, and property, and to promote the public welfare by providing for the licensing and regulation of persons in the practices of engineering and land surveying. This purpose is achieved through the establishment of minimum qualifications for entry into the professions of engineering and land surveying, through the adoption of rules defining and delineating unlawful or unethical conduct, and through swift and effective discipline for those individuals or entities who violate the applicable laws or rules.

Board meeting notices are posted on the Open Meetings area of the website of the Secretary of State, and the Board’s website under Dates and Deadlines. The public can also attend the meeting virtually via the “Board Meeting” link on the website.

Chair Breighner called the meeting to order at 8:00 A.M., Tuesday September 20, 2022, at the Board Office in Montgomery, Alabama. He noted there was a quorum of Members present and the meeting began with the pledge of allegiance and a prayer. The following Members and Staff were in attendance.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed.

22-089. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Vaughn and seconded by Ms. Walton to adopt the agenda as proposed. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

Minutes of the meeting of the 2021-2022 Board held on August 2, 2022, were reviewed.

22-090. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Whorton and seconded by Mr. Vaughn that the minutes of the meeting held August 2, 2022, be approved. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

APPLICATIONS – Mr. Nathan G. Johnson, Advisor

Board staff asked for guidance regarding applications in which the individual fails to answer a question on the application completely or truthfully. The Board gave general guidance and instructed that this type of issue be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure since August 2, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a.1 and a.2, of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity since August 2, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Intern certification since August 2, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure since August 2, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a and b of the Licensure Law, were considered.

22-093. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Johnson to deny for licensure the professional engineer application of John Patrick McKearney, Jr., and Joshua Shea Moody, the professional land surveyor application of Aaron Chance Brown and the Engineer Intern application of Roger Smith. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION – Mr. James C. Pegues, Advisor

The Board authorizes the Executive Director to issue certificates of authorization to applying firms if the application is in order and all requirements have been met. A list of the certificate of authorizations issued since the August 2, 2022, Board Meeting were reviewed.

LAW ENFORCEMENT – Ms. Elaine B. Walton, Advisor

The Board was briefed on the 2021-2022 enforcement statistics and reviewed the status of the files pending with the Investigators, and the Investigative Committee. The cases were discussed in a sanitized format to avoid compromising due process for the Respondent in the event the Board determined another course of action.

APPLICATION HEARING

Anurag Jain, whose professional engineer licensure application was denied at the August 2, 2022, meeting met with the Board electronically at 10 AM. Mr. Jain provided information regarding his application and answered all Board member questions. The Board determined to delay its discussion of the application until later in the Board Meeting.

ENGINEERING – EDUCATION & EXAMINATIONS – Mr. Donald Vaughn, Advisor

Dr. Brett Webb of the University of South Alabama met with the Board to discuss a request that the Board approve its Master of Science in Civil Engineering program.

After the discussion it was agreed Dr. Webb would meet with his faculty and discuss the issues raised at the Board meeting and would then provide additional information to the Board related to the request.

The Board recessed for lunch at 11:10 am and returned at 12:01 pm.

FINANCE – Mr. John E. Averrett, Advisor

The monthly financial report for July 2022 was briefed.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Board discussed proposed meeting dates for the 2022-2023 fiscal year and made the following motion:

22-107. IT WAS MOVED by Ms. Baldwin and seconded by Mr. Robinson that the Board schedule the meeting dates as proposed for FY 2022-2023. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

The Board held an election to fill the positions of Board Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. The following motions were made.

22-108. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Robinson that Mr. Vaughn be elected to serve as Board Chair for the 2022-2023 year. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

22-109. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Vaughn and seconded by Ms. Baldwin that Mr. Averrett be elected to serve as Board Vice Chair for the 2022-2023 year. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

22-110. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Vaughn and seconded by Mr. Johnson that Ms. Baldwin be elected to serve as Board Secretary for the 2022-2023 year. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

PLS LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS DISCUSSION

The Board was briefed that in June, Chair Breighner, Member Nathan Johnson, and Members of Board Staff met with Senator Andrew Jones to discuss his concerns regarding the difficulty in obtaining

licensure as a professional land surveyor in the State of Alabama. At the conclusion of the meeting, it was agreed that a survey would be sent to licensed professional land surveyors asking questions related to the licensure requirements.

Chair Breighner and Board Staff Member Bonnie Kelly and Leadership of the Alabama Society of Professional Land Surveyors (ASPLS) met with Senator Jones on August 30, 2022 and discussed the current professional land surveyor licensure requirements. At the end of the discussion Senator Jones requested the Board and ASPLS to provide him an alternative path for licensure as a professional land surveyor.

After its discussion the Board determined to submit a response to Senator Jones that included a previous recommendation by the Board in 2018 for an alternative path to licensure; and a proposal to change the current experience requirements.

CORRESPONDENCE

The Board discussed a recent Opinion issued by the Attorney General related to its question regarding donating to University scholarship funds. The Board determined it would take no action on the scholarship issue.

The Board reviewed a list of individuals requesting to use the title "Professional Engineer, Retired" or "Professional Land Surveyor, Retired."

22-111. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Vaughn and seconded by Mr. Robinson that the Board ratify the approval of the individuals requesting to use the title "Professional Engineer, Retired" or Professional Land Surveyor, Retired". MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

The Board reviewed correspondence from Dr. Tom Wade requesting "clarification to the law that would stipulate that an Architect or an Engineer can seal drawings for industrial users". Board Attorney Ben Albritton advised the Board that the Alabama Board of Architects determines what is the practice of architecture, and the Board could not render an opinion on what constitutes the practice of architecture in the State.

The Board reviewed a request from Kelly Korn which asked that the firm "Engineering Services Network, Inc," be allowed to keep the word "Engineering" in its name without having to meet the Certificate of Authorization requirements. After review of the information submitted by Ms. Korn, the Code of Alabama and its Rules and Regulations the Board made the following motion:

22-112. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Robinson that "Engineering Services Network, Inc" be required to meet the certificate of authorization requirements in order to use the term "Engineering" in its name. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 1:50 pm, the Board determined that it wished to enter Executive Session to discuss the application and testimony from the application denial hearing of Anurag Jain. Attorney Ben Albritton confirmed that it was permissible for the Board to enter Executive Session for this matter.



At 2:00 pm the Board exited Executive Session and made the following motion:


