ALSS Exam Requirements

The ALSS Exam is a computer based exam. It allows for the exam candidate to sit at their computer and be monitored behind the scenes. The exam is a 2 hour **closed book** exam. You must be approved by the Board prior to sitting for the exam. Currently the exam is given year round. Once you submit the exam fee, you will contact the office about an exam date and time. Below is a list of what is needed to take the ALSS Exam:

- Computer with added Webcam or a Laptop with a built in camera (cell phones will not be acceptable)
- Broadband Internet access
- Built in speaker and microphone on computer or external speaker and microphone (no headphones)
- A quiet room where you will not be interrupted during the test



In the same email will also be the UserID and Password. You will click the ALSS Online Exam link to login.

Enter Login and Password from the email. (It's best to copy and paste the password from the email)





Once you hit close, you should see this screen. Hit Log off




After the Exam/Results
