

**ALABAMA BOARD OF LICENSURE FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS  
MINUTES – JANUARY 18, 2023  
Montgomery, Alabama**

The Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was established by legislative action in 1935. Its charter is to protect the public by helping to safeguard life, health, and property, and to promote the public welfare by providing for the licensing and regulation of persons in the practices of engineering and land surveying. This purpose is achieved through the establishment of minimum qualifications for entry into the professions of engineering and land surveying, through the adoption of rules defining and delineating unlawful or unethical conduct, and through swift and effective discipline for those individuals or entities who violate the applicable laws or rules.

Board meeting notices are posted on the Open Meetings area of the website of the Secretary of State, and the Board’s website under Dates and Deadlines. The public can also attend the meeting virtually via the “Board Meeting” link on the website.

Chair Vaughn called the meeting to order at 8:00 A.M., Wednesday January 18, 2023, at the Board Office in Montgomery, Alabama. He noted there was a quorum of Members present and the meeting began with the pledge of allegiance and a prayer. The following Members and Staff were in attendance.

The proposed meeting agenda was reviewed.

23-018. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Breighner and seconded by Mr. Averrett to adopt the agenda as proposed. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

Minutes of the meeting of the 2022-2023 Board held on November 15, 2022, were reviewed.

23-019. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Pegues and seconded by Mr. Averrett that the minutes of the meeting held November 15, 2022, be approved. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

**APPLICATIONS** – Mr. Nathan G. Johnson, Advisor

Board staff asked for guidance regarding applications in which the individual fails to answer a question on the application completely or truthfully. The Board gave general guidance and instructed that this type of issue be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

The Board previously authorized the Executive Director to approve applications for licensure, intern certification, and examinations if the application is in order and all requirements have been met.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure since November 15, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)a.1 and a.2, of the Licensure Law having previously passed the FE Examination in Alabama or in another jurisdiction, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Engineer licensure by comity since November 15, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(1)(b) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Intern certification since November 15, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(2) of the Licensure Law, were considered.

Applications of those applying for Professional Land Surveyor licensure since November 15, 2022, as provided by Section 34-11-4(3)a and b of the Licensure Law, were considered.

The Board was briefed on the 2022-2023 enforcement statistics and reviewed the status of the files pending with the Investigators, and the Investigative Committee. The cases were discussed in a sanitized format to avoid compromising due process for the Respondent in the event the Board determined another course of action.

Steve Strickland, professional land surveyor and President of the Alabama Society of Professional Land Surveyors (ASPLS) spoke with the Board regarding the discontinuation of the use of the US Survey Foot. He advised that as of December 31, 2022, the US Survey Foot became obsolete and was replaced by International Survey Foot. After the discussion the Board determined to include an article in its newsletter regarding the change to the International Survey Foot.

Tony Manary, professional land surveyor and Dave Scoggins with the City of Huntsville, met with the Board to discuss the requirements by the City of Huntsville to include engineering design information on survey plats. The Board suggested that any engineering design or certification be on a separate page when submitted with the survey plat.

## **APPLICATION HEARINGS**

John F. Germ, whose professional engineer licensure application was denied at the November 15, 2022, meeting met with the Board electronically at 10 AM. Mr. Germ provided information regarding

his application and answered all Board member questions. At the conclusion of the hearing the Board made the following motion:

23-041. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Johnson to deny the appeal of the denied professional engineer licensure application of John F. Germ. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

Tanya Walkenbach whose professional engineer licensure application was denied at the November 15, 2022, meeting, and her attorney Johnathan Head met with the Board at 10:30 AM. Mr. Head and Dr. Walkenbach provided information regarding her application and answered all Board member questions. At the conclusion of the hearing the Board made the following motion:

23-042. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Ms. Baldwin to approve for licensure the professional engineer licensure application of Tanya Walkenbach. MOTION CARRIED 5-1 with Mr. Averrett voting no and Ms. Walton and Mr. Pegues recused.

**FINANCE – Mr. John E. Averrett, Advisor**

The monthly financial reports for October and November 2022 were briefed.

**LEGISLATION – Mr. Randy Whorton, Advisor**

The Board reviewed correspondence from Senator Andrew Jones inquiring if the Board would consider submitting a rule change to allow applicants for licensure as professional land surveyors to receive more surveying experience credit for experience earned prior to graduation. After review and discussion, the Board made the following motion:

23-043. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Ms. Walton that the Board submit a proposed rule change to the Legislative Services Agency for publication and to begin the rule change process. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR’S REPORT**

The Board was briefed on the changes to the PE structural exam as it moves to a computer-based format, and the possible changes to the professional land surveyor exam.

The Board approved Benjamin T. Proctor, professional land surveyor and Richard T. Collins, professional land surveyor to serve as Board Technical Advisors.

**QUALIFICATION BASED SELECTION**

Board Member Randy Whorton provided an update regarding conversations with the Department of Finance concerning the impact of Act 2021-296 on the procurement process for State funded projects, and its conflict with the Board’s statute regarding qualification-based selection of professional engineers and professional land surveyors.

## CORRESPONDENCE

The Board reviewed a list of individuals requesting to use the title "Professional Engineer, Retired" or "Professional Land Surveyor, Retired."

23-044. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Breighner that the Board ratify the approval of the individuals requesting to use the title "Professional Engineer, Retired" or Professional Land Surveyor, Retired". MOTION CARRIED 7-0 with Ms. Walton not voting.

The Board reviewed correspondence from David B. Williams requesting that Templeton & Associates Engineering Sales, Inc be allowed to keep the word "Engineering" in its name without having to meet the Certificate of Authorization requirements. After this review the Board made the following motion:

23-045. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Pegues and seconded by Mr. Averrett that in order for Templeton & Associates Engineering Sales, Inc to use the term "Engineering" in its name it must meet the Certificate of Authorization requirements. MOTION CARRIED 7-0 with Ms. Walton not voting.


The Board went to lunch at 12:07. Returned at 12:45 PM.




## ADJOURN TIME


