

**ALABAMA BOARD OF LICENSURE FOR  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS  
MINUTES – OCTOBER 7, 2025  
Montgomery, Alabama**

The Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was established by legislative action in 1935. Its charter is to protect the public by helping to safeguard life, health, and property, and to promote the public welfare by providing for the licensing and regulation of persons in the practices of engineering and land surveying. This purpose is achieved through the establishment of minimum qualifications for entry into the professions of engineering and land surveying, through the adoption of rules defining and delineating unlawful or unethical conduct, and through swift and effective discipline for those individuals or entities who violate the applicable laws or rules.

Board meeting notices are posted on the Open Meetings area of the website of the Secretary of State, and the Board's website under Dates and Deadlines. The public can also attend the meeting virtually via the "Board Meeting" link on the website.

Mrs. Page briefed the Board that as of October 7, 2025, sixty-four bills had been pre-filed for the 2026 legislative session.

**EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

At its June 17, 2025, meeting the Board met with ALDOT representatives Anthony (Tony) Higgins, Assistant Counsel, Bill Patty, Chief Counsel, and Ed Austin, Chief Engineer to discuss a recent communication from the City of Madison concerning design documents. Don Vaughn, former Chief Engineer for ALDOT and former Board Member also attended the discussion. Information was provided that outlined ALDOT's process for certifying design documents.

The Board discussed the meeting and determined that it would submit a resolution to the Attorney General for an opinion relating to the statutes in question.

The Board reviewed the proposed meeting calendar for FY2025-2026, and made the following motion:

The Board reviewed a list of individuals requesting to use the title "Professional Engineer, Retired" or "Professional Land Surveyor, Retired."

Gregory Potter submitted a request that Sunrise Engineering LLC be allowed to use the term "Engineering" in its name without meeting the certificate of authorization requirements.

After review of the information provided and its discussion the Board determined the use of the term in its name tended to convey the impression the firm was offering engineering services and made the following motion:

26-029. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Breighner that if “Sunrise Engineering LLC” wished to use the term “Engineering” in its name it must meet the Board’s certificate of authorization requirements. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

Attorney Algert Agricola submitted a request that “Security Engineering Inc” be allowed to use the term “Engineering” in its name without meeting the certificate of authorization requirements.

After review of the information provided and its discussion the Board determined the use of the term in its name tended to convey the impression the firm was offering engineering services and made the following motion:

26-030. IT WAS MOVED by Mr. Averrett and seconded by Mr. Brooks that if “Security Engineering Inc” wished to use the term “Engineering” in its name it must meet the Board’s certificate of authorization requirements. MOTION CARRIED 9-0.

Deana Nguyen, a representative of Terracon Consultants, Inc., submitted an email inquiring if Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasures plans (SPCC) could be completed by entities for facilities in Alabama without the involvement of a licensed engineer. The Board discussed the issue and instructed staff to advise Ms. Nguyen that an Alabama licensed professional engineer was required.

Kavita Dawson submitted a request that the Board allow “Maven Engineering Corp” to keep the term “Engineering” in its name without having to meet the Certificate of Authorization requirements.

After review of the information provided the Board determined the date the company began using the name “Maven Engineering Corp” was needed and deferred this request until the firm provided the additional information.


Attorney Andy Crowder confirmed that it was permissible for the Board to enter Executive Session for this matter.
